**During the summer at RPTS, students are encouraged to pursue internships, or they may seek to arrange independent studies with permission from a faculty member. In addition to the above possibilities, intensive courses are available. Registration for these courses is from January 24-April 8 (to avoid a late fee).**

In 2022, the following intensive courses are offered:

May 31-June 3:

SH520 *Dynamics of Public Speaking* (3 credits) with Dr. Calvin Troup

The **Doctor of Ministry (DMin)** program meets for two weeks each August in one-week intensive courses. The first full week of August, students in both the Pastoral Ministry and Counseling Ministry programs participate in a required course common to both concentrations.
