During the summer at RPTS, students are encouraged to pursue internships, or they may seek to arrange independent studies with permission from a faculty member. In addition to the above possibilities, intensive courses are available.

In 2020, the following intensive courses are offered:

May 26-29:

SH44 *Dynamics of Public Speaking* (3 credits) with Dr. Calvin Troup

MS31 *Theology & Methods of Missions* (3 credits) with Mr. Vince Ward

September 1-September 4:

MS72 *Church Planting* (3 credits) with Dr. Barry York

Registration for these courses is from March 9-31.

The **Doctor of Ministry (DMin)** program meets for two weeks each August in one-week intensive courses. The first full week of August, students in both the Pastoral Ministry and Counseling Ministry programs participate in a required course common to both concentrations.
